

William „Bill% Dusenberry for Union President (a \$10,000 reward is involved)

Achievements:

- Exposed a ten-year „no-show% job by a full professor (a close friend of President Hernandez) ^ investigated by Office of the Inspector General (*copy of report available upon request*). As a result, the taxpayers of New Jersey saved hundreds of thousands of dollars by ending this „no-show% job and placing NJCU on notice that this will no longer be tolerated.
- Exposed the use of a fraudulent credential by President Hernandez, who used an MA in psychology for a period of 20 years, most significantly, when he was promoted to Vice President of Academic Affairs. In reality, he was made the Vice President of Academic Affairs (the highest academic position at the university) with a BA in psychology (*copy of letter from the New Jersey Commission on Higher Education available upon request*).

If elected, I will:

- Establish a policy to protect whistleblowers
- Conduct a needs assessment for NJCU's administrative positions (*we have too many administrators*)
- Conduct a credential audit for all NJCU

employees (*to expose the use of fraudulent credentials similar to Dr. Hernandez' fraudulent use of a an MA when he was made Vice president of Academic Affairs*)

- End the contract with the University of Phoenix (*a serious threat to our jobs, the past Union leadership supported NJCU's collaboration with the University of Phoenix*)
- Suspend union dues until the current fund (\$500,000) is reduced to less than \$100,000 (*our contract prohibits strikes*)
- End the exploitation of adjunct faculty. They should be paid on a pro-rated scale based on full-time faculty's salary. Also, there should be ranks of assistant, associate and full adjunct professorships just like in other institutions
- Strengthen the grievance committee (*the present system is weak, timid, and administration-friendly*)
- Resist future plans of administration to track faculty's time and whereabouts (*similar to Kean University's use of electronic monitoring of IDs*)
